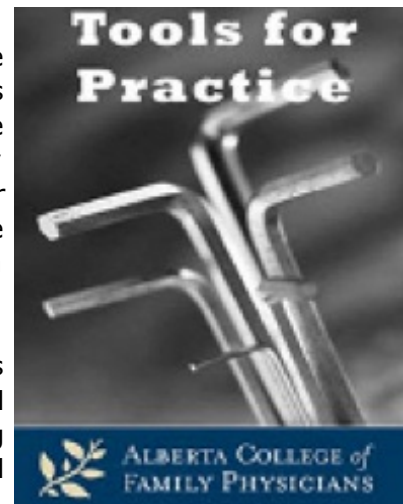

The College of Family Physicians of Canada (CFPC) is proposing changes to the structure and function of its Board of Directors to enhance governance and efficiencies, and introduce new opportunities for stakeholders - like our Chapter - to interact with the CFPC Board and influence its direction. It is important for you to know what the proposed changes mean to the Nova Scotia College of Family Physicians. Please be assured that the development of the proposal has included extensive consultation with our Chapter's elected officials on the Nova Scotia Executive. We were involved during each step of its development, and we are in support of the proposed changes.

Highlights of the proposal include:

- * A smaller CFPC Board of Directors that is skills and experience-based and reflective of the CFPC's pan-Canadian membership. All CFPC members are eligible to respond to the Call for Nominations to participate on the Board. The smaller Board is intended to enhance dialogue and interaction.

- * Greater opportunity for stakeholders, including our Chapter, to provide feedback and ideas for CFPC Board agendas; to connect with the CFPC President, Executive Director, and CEO before and after Board meetings to be kept abreast of discussions and provide input; to have the full attention of the CFPC Board Directors as they participate with us in the annual Chapter Symposium focused on how the 10 Chapters collaborate and work with each other and the national CFPC office; and through our participation in the Annual Forum an opportunity to dialogue about topics being discussed by the Board, and share topics important to us with other CFPC
